CHILLING REQUIREMENT	CHILLING REQUIREMENT : 600 hours – 300 hours less than the reference Hayward
BUD BREAK	First days of March (South West of France) – earlier than Hayward
FLOWERING	Late April (South West of France) – earlier than Hayward
HARVEST	Early/Mid-September (South West of France) – earlier than Hayward. No risk of frost in autumn.
SUGGESTED POLLINATOR	ZUVA
COMMERCIAL YIELD	High. 30 to 35 T/ha (according to soil quality)
PEST AND DISEASE	PSA sensitive. Phytophthora and Armillaria sp. (no insect found in Europe).
SUGGESTED GROWING AREA	Dry Mediterranean climate or Oceanic climate with rain and frost protection.
FRUIT STORAGE	90 days under normal atmosphere – 120 days under controlled atmosphere.
REMARKS	Good complementarity in the organization of work regarding thinning, pruning and harvesting with a culture of Hayward.
